Dear Parents / Guardians

To continue preparing our learners for the demands of formal examinations, Roosevelt High School will once again conduct a **Testing Week** for all Grade 8–11 learners during Term 3, from **THURSDAY 20 AUGUST – MONDAY 31 AUGUST**. This initiative forms an important part of our assessment programme and encourages learners to develop effective study habits and examination techniques.

Our **Grade 12 learners** will officially commence their **Preliminary Examinations on Wednesday, 19 August**. Please find the **Grade 12 Preliminary Examination Timetable** attached for your reference.

Testing Week provides learners with the opportunity to complete scheduled cycle tests under formal assessment conditions while developing valuable examination techniques, study habits and time management skills.

During Testing Week, **Grade 8–11 learners may write a maximum of two assessment sessions per day**. All assessments will be written under normal school supervision in their allocated venues.

Each school day will include:

- Register
- Supervised study sessions
- Break
- Two scheduled cycle test sessions

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Normal school times will apply throughout Testing Week:

- **Monday, Tuesday & Thursday:** 07:37 – 14:15
- **Wednesday:** 07:37 – 13:25
- **Friday :** 07:37 – 12:30 **(21 & 28 August)** (Please note that the school day will end 30 minutes earlier to accommodate our Muslim learners).

Learners are expected to make productive use of the supervised study sessions by preparing for upcoming assessments whenever they are not writing a scheduled cycle test.

Testing Week forms part of the normal academic programme, and **full attendance is compulsory throughout the week.** Learners are expected to attend school for the entire school day, regardless of the number of assessments they are scheduled to write.

ONCE TESTING WEEK HAS CONCLUDED, TEACHING AND LEARNING WILL CONTINUE AS NORMAL FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM. It is therefore essential that learners continue attending school every day to ensure that they do not miss valuable teaching time. **School will officially close on Wednesday 23 September for Term 3.**

Should a learner be absent during Testing Week, an **official medical certificate** must be submitted, as these assessments form part of the school's Formal Assessment Programme. Arrangements for any missed assessment will only be considered upon receipt of the required supporting documentation.

We thank you for your continued support and partnership in ensuring that our learners approach Testing Week and the Preliminary Examinations with responsibility, commitment and a focus on academic excellence.

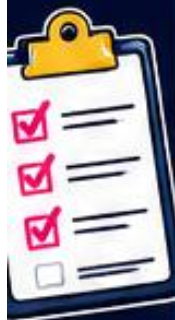
